- In most cases you will have lab work done the day of the preoperative appointment. Fasting is not needed for lab work.
- You will be required to present immunization records at the appointment (ages 18 and under)
- You will not be able to eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery.
- The hospital may ask you to arrive one to two hours prior to your surgery time.
- If you will be staying in Flagstaff from out of town and need a place to stay, we can provide you with a list of hotels offering reduced rates.
- Please confirm your home phone number and an additional contact number prior to your surgery in case our office needs to contact you immediately before your scheduled surgery.
- If you become ill between now and your preoperative appointment, please contact us immediately.
- In the event you can not keep any of the above appointments, we ask that you give us the courtesy of two weeks notice in order to allow another patient the opportunity to have their surgery sooner.
- Our office will preauthorize your procedure for you. Authorization does not guarantee payment, it also factors in deductibles, co-insurance and pre-existing conditions. Questions regarding authorizations may be directed to our insurance coordinator at Crystal Canyon ENT & Facial Plastic Surgery. If we have any problems authorizing your surgery, we will contact you.

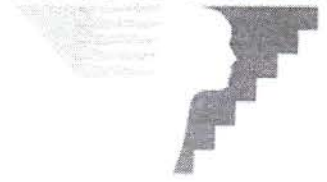

You may receive as many as 5 separate bills for your procedure, depending on what is done. They will be from:

1. Your Surgeon
2. The Facility where procedure is done
3. The Anesthesiologist
4. The Pathologist (if something is removed)
5. The Assistant Surgeon (for example: thyroid surgery, parotid surgery, major surgery or neck surgery)
